Proposed By-laws Changes for 2018.

<u>Proposed changes are underlined.</u>

Amend Article VII, Sec. 2 Responsibilities of Treasurer as follows:

f) At his discretion set up various funds, such as "Museum", "Ships", Relief Fund, etc, with the approval of the Executive Board. Any funds so designated must conform to the requirements of Article II.

Replace Article X with the following: Article X DUES:

Sec. 1 The dues of the U.S.S. Coral Sea CVA-43 shall be \$20.00 per year for the period of January 1st to December 31th. Any dues increase must be recommended by the Executive Board and voted on by the members present at the annual business meeting. Any increase would be retroactive to January 1st. of the year in which the increase is approved. All plank owners i.e. all those on the Ship's original commissioning crew shall pay no membership fee. All those whose birthdate is prior to December 31, 1932 shall pay no dues.

Sec. 2 All former Commanding Officers of USS Coral Sea shall pay no dues.

Sec. 3 Any delinquent members may be reinstated by the payment of current dues.



Generally speaking, you're not learning much when your lips are moving.

With a crew of more than 4,000, Coral Sea is a self-contained city. Within her armored hull are many of the same jobs and positions available in most American cities and towns.

Coral Sea has the resources available to enhance its crewmembers physically, intellectually and spiritually. She is equipped with a professional weight room; she has a 3,000-plus volume library and offers college courses; her Religious Ministries Department offers worship services for five denominations.

At first, Coral Sea may overwhelm you. Here is a list of facts and statistics to help fill out her hull:

A 5,000 pound automobile would travel 2.5 miles if shot from one of Coral Sea's three steam-driven catapults. Average daily sales in Coral Sea's four stores exceed \$10,000. Coral Sea's WSEA-TV and KREW radio stations provide the crew with 24-hour FM radio and three channels of television programming over the ship's closed circuit system. Twelve oil-fed boilers feed four main engines for a total of 212,000 shaft horsepower.

All welded seams, if laid in a straight line, would extend from Norfolk to San Francisco, a length of more than 2.400 miles.

Since commissioning, Coral Sea has traveled more than two million miles, which is equal to four round trips to the moon.

USS Coral Sea Association Membership Application/Renewal Form

Membership in the USS CORAL SEA CVA-43 ASSOCIATON is open to all Navy, Marine Corp and Air Force personnel who served aboard the ship (CV/CVB/CVA-43) for a period of at least 90 days. Also, any person who was assigned to the <u>original commissioning crew</u> (plank owner), even if they spent fewer than 90 days aboard, shall be eligible for membership. <u>DUES</u>: Association membership is \$20 per year. Dues for membership are not limited to one year when submitted for renewal or first-time application. Any amount submitted over the annual dues will be automatically earmarked for the Association's Scholarship Fund program.
