Introduction of Shipmates was done.

Minutes of the 2017 business meeting were read & approved as corrected.

Minutes of the 2018 Board of Directors meeting were read & approved as corrected.

Treasurers report: Clarence Neander gave the current financial report (see attachment). Motion made by ,2nd. by to accept the treasurers report as presented. Motion carried.

Committee reports:

Bill Johnson reported information on a record book will be available as soon as possible.

Sea Cadets: Richard Satchell reported on the status of the Coral Sea Cadet Division. He will have a report published in "Sea Breeze". He detailed the current status of the Division. Good progress is being made. Currently 3 Sea Cadets are enrolled in the USNA. He noted that due to his health concerns, a replacement for him is needed. 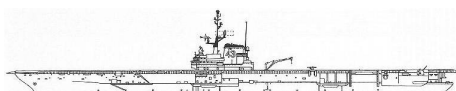
